Selection Test and Interview is conducted for shortlisted applicants.</p> <p>3. Chinese Language Elective Programme (LEPC) Able to demonstrate talents in Chinese Language/Chinese Literature beyond abilities of your peers. Accomplish achievements in Chinese language or Literature competition at national or international level (e.g. published articles in national journal, Chinese Literacy Writing or Chinese Drama/Song writing competitions). Interview is conducted for shortlisted applicants.</p> <p>4. Mathematics/Science /Science Research Able to demonstrate talents in mathematics or science beyond abilities of your peers. Accomplish achievements in related national/international competitions (e.g. Science/Mathematics/Informatics Olympiad, Future Problem Solving competitions, Singapore Science & Engineering Fair, published research paper/article in national/international journal). Interview is conducted for shortlisted applicants.</p>

1. After submitting the application form online, you will be prompted to **print a copy of the completed form**. Attach the following documents to the application form:
 - Photocopies of Sec 3 (MYE & EOY) results and Sec 4 (CA & MYE) results (you can submit MYE results later if it is not ready at the time of application)
 - Photocopied records of CCA achievements; qualifications (highest level only); awards or scholarships that are evidence of special talent, if any.
 - Sealed Teacher Reference Letter (Optional)
2. The completed form with supporting documents must reach the College Reception by 14 June 2019 (Friday), 5 pm. Please note that the College Reception Opening hours: Monday to Friday (excluding Public holidays) from 8 am to 5 pm.
